

Administration of the Sacraments

BAPTISM. Baptismal Preparation is held once a month at the Church.

CONFIRMATION. In our Diocese, Confirmation & First Eucharist are celebrated together in Grade 2. Sacramental Preparations begin in January. Both parents and children are required to participate at the Sacramental Preparations.

RECONCILIATION. Celebrated by those who have already received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist.) Parish Reconciliation is available every Saturday evening before the Anticipated Mass or by appointment.

MARRIAGE. Please make an appointment with the pastor, at least six months before the intended marriage date. Marriage Preparation may then be arranged.

CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY (Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament)

We invite and remind all parishioners to join in prayer as there will be an exposition of the Blessed Sacrament today at 5:00 PM at St. Anthony's Parish. It is an hour of adoration. This is an invitation from our Bishop Stephen Jensen in unity with our Pope Francis who will lead an hour of Eucharistic Adoration in Rome in celebration of faith in the Holy Eucharist.



CORPUS CHRISTI

The Feast of Corpus Christi (Latin for Body of Christ), also known as Corpus Domini, is a Latin

Rite liturgical solemnity celebrating the tradition and belief in the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ and his Real Presence in the Eucharist. It emphasizes the joy of the institution of the Eucharist, which was observed on Holy Thursday in the somber atmosphere of the nearness of Good Friday.

The feast is liturgically celebrated on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday or, "where the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is not a Holy Day of Obligation, it is assigned to the Sunday after the Most Holy Trinity as its proper day". At the end of Holy Mass, there is often a procession of the Blessed Sacrament, generally displayed in a monstrance. The procession is followed by Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.
