This special joint emergency campaign for Syria began on Sunday June 30th and will continue throughout the summer. It will culminate with a day of prayer and fasting for the people of Syria and all the Middle East on Saturday, September 14th, the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. In a letter addressed to Catholics in Canada, Archbishop Richard Smith, President of the CCCB, together with Pope Francis and all the Bishops of Canada, invites Catholics to be in solidarity with the people of Syria in their many sufferings from war, violence and displacement. All donations need to be in by September 14th.

World Youth day celebration will start on July 23-28, 2013 at Rio de Janero, Brazil. The theme for this years' gathering which was unveiled by Pope Rio2013 Benedic XVI days after the World Youth Day of 2011 in Madrid closed is "Go and make disciples

of all nations." From the Gospel of Matthew (28:19) which is also understood as the great commissioning. It will be the 28th World Meeting of Youth from different countries since 1985. "The main objective of World Youth Day (WYD) is to make known to all youth of the world the message of Christ, but it is also true that, through them, the "face" of young Christ is also shown to the world...The World Youth Day, held annually in the dioceses of the world, provides every 2 or 3 years an international meeting of young people with the Pope, which lasts about a week. The latest edition of the International Youth Day was held in August 2011, in Madrid, Spain, and brought together more than 190 countries. (www.rio2013.com)."
