Everyone is invited to come and celebrate all that we are thankful for at our mass on Friday, October 11<sup>th</sup> at 11:00am. The Grade 3 class has



prepared this mass. After mass we will have our Thanksgiving Lunch. You are welcome to join us for lunch; however, we will only be able to seat 60 extra people so please contact us promptly if you would like to join us for lunch. Unfortunately, if you do not reserve a spot for lunch, you will not be able to attend. We just do not have the space and we have to know the numbers for food preparation. Because of a shortage of place settings, we are asking guests to bring their own plate and cutlery, if at all possible.

We ask that parents and siblings over two years of age pay \$4.00 per person. Students of our school do not need to pay.

We are also asking for donations of potatoes and carrots for our Thanksgiving lunch. If you would like to donate please have these vegetables into the school by Wednesday, October 9th, as we peel and prepare these on Thursday. There will be container in the school foyer for your donations. Thank you.

Help is needed for making the stuffing and preparing the turkeys on Wednesday, starting at 8:30am and for preparing the meal on Thursday at 10:00am. Volunteers are also needed for serving the meal and especially for clean up after the meal. If you are able to assist in any way, please call the office. Thank you!

#### PARKING LOT PROCEDURES - Just a reminder

- ⇒ Vehicles are NOT to be parked along the school building from the double doors to the end of the pavement. This is drop off only.
- ⇒ If the parent needs to get out of the vehicle for any reason the vehicle must be parked in the designated parking area beyond the crosswalk
- ⇒ Vehicles are to follow the one way arrow and drive slowly, single file in the lane.
- ⇒ All traffic is to enter via 1st Ave and exit via Broadway Ave.
- ⇒ Vehicles that park by the rectory are to have their headlights facing the school.
- ⇒ Vehicles may park along the wooden fence, but must back in.
- ⇒ Vehicles are to stop for pedestrians and cyclists. There is a stop sign at the crosswalk.
- ⇒ Cyclists and pedestrians are to cross the parking lot at the cros walk. All must walk.
- $\Rightarrow$  Crosswalks are to be used to reach parked vehicles across the parking lot.
- ⇒ No playing in the parking lot.



Reflection on Stewardship

Deep stewardship begins with gratitude and ends with responsibility. Stewardship is sometimes called "the attitude of gratitude." We recognize gratefully that everything in life is a gift of God. We do not ultimately own anything, but are entrusted with time, talent, and treasure for use during our passage through this life. And at the end of life, we take nothing with us, except the life which arise out of generous love. If each of us is profoundly aware that all is gift, then we are freed from possessiveness, and can be good stewards of what has been entrusted to us in life, sharing generously and so at the end of life returning all to the Lord with increase. Stewardship ends with responsibility and accountability. Like the servants in the parable, we will be called to account for the way in which we have used what has been entrusted to us.
