Now, I feel, WE have done something concrete for the victims and survivors aside from the monetary donations. It brought a sense of relief that we are not alone on our journey.

As we are all very aware of, the destruction brought by the Super Typhoon Haiyan is huge. Administration of the Sacraments

MARRIAGE. Please make an appointment with the pastor, at least six months before the intended marriage date. Marriage Preparation may then be arranged.

HOLY ORDERS. Any person interested to become a priest, please see the pastor.


