Dear Sisters and Brothers, Parishioners of St. Joseph's & St. Anthony's:

Greetings of Peace!

As I celebrate Mass this weekend, I also mark my last weekend with you. Let me share with you my heart full of gratitude for more than six years that you allowed me to journey with all of you. THANK YOU VERY MUCH to all of you my dear parishioners for the many ways you have shown your support, hospitality, generosity, love and care to me as your pastor. Please know how deeply grateful I am for all that you have done to me during my ministry with you. St. Joseph's Parish and School and St. Anthony's Parish will forever occupy a special place in my heart.

May I also share with you what waits ahead of me as I leave Smithers and take my Sabbatical Year. I will fly to the Philippines on July 1. For the whole month of July up to mid-August, I will process the renewal of my passport, apply for a US student Visa, and visit with families. Starting Fall this year, I am registered to The Liturgical Insitute, Mundelein Seminary, Illinois. I will begin to study Master of Arts in Liturgical Studies. For Christmas 2014 and Easter 2015, I will be able to celebrate it with my family in the Philippines. January 2015, I will undergo a priest-renewal program in Holy Land. In May, the hope is to do a 30 days retreat. June 2015, I will go back to The Liturgical Institute for another semester. August 2015 I am expected to return to the Diocese for a new assignment coming from Bishop Stephen Jensen. I feel so blessed to be given a chance to do a Sabbatical Year.

As I leave and start another phase of my journey, may I leave you with similar words that St. Paul said to the Ephesians: "I am a witness to your faith and service to the Lord, for this reason, I do not cease to give THANKS for you as I remember you in my prayers" (cf. Eph 1:15-16)

Thank you again, Smithers and Houston. God bless you all. See you in the future!
