### Pastor's Notes



Christian Reformed Church, Smithers will use St. Joseph's Catholic Church for their Sunday Worship beginning October 5, 2014

In the spirit of friendship, hospitality and Ecumenism, the Parish Pastoral Council and I have accepted the request coming from the Christian Reformed Church to use our Church beginning Fall 2014 for a period of one year. This request was submitted to Most Reverend Stephen Jensen, Bishop, Diocese of Prince George. Bishop Jensen approved the request

with the following citations:

"Catholic Churches are consecrated or blessed buildings which have an important theological and liturgical significance for the Catholic Community. They are therefore generally reserved for Catholic worship. However, if priests, ministers or communities not in full communion with the Catholic Church do not have a place or the liturgical objects necessary for celebrating worthily their religious ceremonies, the diocesan Bishop may allow them the use of a church or a Catholic building and also lend them what may be necessary for their services. Under similar circumstances, permission may be given to them for internment or for the celebration of services at Catholic cemeteries." (#137, Directory for the Application of Principles and Norms on Ecumenism)

A committee has been formed from both Churches to deal with matters related to the use of the Church. The first meeting will take place tomorrow, Monday, June 16th, 7pm at the Parish Center.

In the letter sent to us by Ron Van Driel of Christian Reformed Church, he mentioned: "We sincerely thank you for considering our request for the use of your facilities. We hope our interaction with St. Joseph's Parish will be a positive experience for all of us, will be a mutually satisfactory arrangement and will strengthen relations between St. Joseph's Parish and the Smithers Christian Reformed Church."





#### The Dogma of the Holy Trinity (In Brief: from CCC 261-267)

**261** The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and of Christian life. God alone can make it known to us by revealing himself as Father, Son and Holy Spirit.





**264** "The Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father as the first principle and, by the eternal gift of this to the Son, from the communion of both the Father and the Son" (St. Augustine, De Trin. 15, 26, 47: PL 42, 1095).

**265** By the grace of Baptism "in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit", we are called to share in the life of the Blessed Trinity, here on earth in the obscurity of faith, and after death in eternal light (cf. Paul VI,CPG § 9).

**266** "Now this is the Catholic faith: We worship one God in the Trinity and the Trinity in unity, without either confusing the persons or dividing the substance; for the person of the Father is one, the Son's is another, the Holy Spirit's another; but the Godhead of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit is one, their glory equal, their majesty coeternal" (Athanasian Creed: DS 75; ND 16).

**267** Inseparable in what they are, the divine persons are also inseparable in what they do. But within the single divine operation each shows forth what is proper to him in the Trinity, especially in the divine missions of the Son's Incarnation and the gift of the Holy Spirit.
