# **PASTOR'S NOTE**

#### SUNDAY REFLECTION AND ACTION ITEM:

**LATE CONVERSION** and **DEEDS COUNT** are the two themes we take from the scriptures this week. It is a simple parable of two sons, one son promising but not delivering obedience, and the other son initially refusing but eventually offering obedience. The words of Jesus are clear that a late conversion is better than any illusion that we have need of no conversion. This conversion becomes real in deeds of action.


Continuing with a reference to the Diocesan Appeal where we are being asked to put into action our TIME, TALENT, and TREASURE to "building together in faith", we can ask what conversion is God asking of us.. and we can do ONE THING DIFFERENTLY THIS WEEK with our time, our talents, or our treasure.

#### **NEWS**

The Diocese is gathering for its annual STUDY DAYS from Oct I to Oct 3. These days remind us of our need to be reviewing and deepening our understanding of faith. Pope Frances, with his experiences of life with the Jesuits and brush with liberation theology and pastoral life in Argentina, has produced a document called the Joy of the Gospel. We will be using this document as our resource. This document is available at the Vatican website.

While it may not be possible for all to come to Prince George, there are opportunities locally that I would encourage you to consider. There is are Faith Groups meeting Tuesday morning to study the bible and on Wednesday evening to study faith (look for ads in bulletin for more information.) And on Oct 4 there is the Life Chain organized by Pro Life that I would recommend.

The various parish ministry groups have met with me. First, I am grateful for their faithful commitment and participation; and second, I will be inviting parishioners to join in ministry to bolster the numbers and to ensure that ministry is always a privilege and not a burden. It becomes a burden when a volunteer is always asked or when the volunteer is unable to do their ministry well because other ministry spots are vacant. Call the office if you are interested.



Prayer to Our Lady of the Rosary O Virgin Mary, grant that the recitation of thy Rosary may be for me each day, in the midst of my manifold duties, a bond of unity in my actions, a tribute of filial piety, a sweet refreshment, an

So shall I acquire the habit of praying while I work, without the aid of formal prayers, by interior acts of admiration and of supplication, or by aspirations of love. I ask this of thee, O Queen of the Holy Rosary, through Saint Dominic, thy son of predilection, the renowned preacher of thy mysteries, and the faithful imitator of thy virtues. Amen.
