### **PASTOR'S NOTE**

#### SUNDAY REFLECTION AND ACTION ITEM:

The call from the King. The parable of the wedding feast reveals how insistent God is to calling us to share in His riches. Our job is to discern this call in the midst of today's society, and we do this with the Spirit given to us at Baptism and nourished with every Eucharist. Indifference and unworthiness are the two ways presented by the parable that we scorn this Call from God. Let us respond with commitment and humble respectfulness.

The Diocesan priests will be on retreat. 'You cannot give what you do not have' is a phrase we are used to. As a priest I am asked to give God's prayer and forgiveness, God's joy and peace, God's friendship and support. I cannot give what I have not first received from God. My time in the seminary was where I first received God's gifts which eventually helped me to say yes to the priesthood. Each year when I go on retreat, I allow God to renew these gifts so that I can in turn share then with you. (PS. God has never given me the gift of graciously losing at cards, nor do I expect things to change.)

Home visits are being planned. I do not expect you to stop what you are doing. My home visits are to be done in the atmosphere of everyday life. If I arrive when dishes are being washed, I will pick up the dish towel; if a driveway is being cleared, I will pick up a shovel; if your child is playing sports, I will join in the cheering. I will begin with the parish list and anyone who is recommended. My focus is to find what are your expectations of the Church.




#### ALTAR SERVERS NEEDED



Vastican City, 7 OCotober 2014 (VIS) The second general congregation, held yesterday afternoon, opened the discussion of the Extraordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops. The theme, according to the agenda set forth in the Instrumentum Labotis, was: "God's Plan for Marriage and the Family from Sacred Scripture Church Documents" (Part 1, Chapter 2)
