In this way we understand the comment in the letter from Bishop Jensen which indicates that Stewardship is not about giving to a specific cause but about recognizing "our need to give".

#### **LOCAL OUTREACH PROGRAMS**

St. Joseph's Church and School support the local food bank and Broadway Homeless Shelter through donations of items by our families. Students can bring items into the school and items can be brought over at Friday mass time.

St. Joseph's Parish Apple Pie Sale is coming! Pie crust roll out day is Friday, September 26, starting at 9:00 a.m. in the school kitchen. Bring your rolling pins and energy, and we will fill the pans with pastry. On Saturday we will make the pies starting at 8:00 a.m. Some of the pies will be baked, and others will remain uncooked. When you order your pies stipulate whether cooked or uncooked. Both types can be frozen.

Pies can be picked up Saturday afternoon in the school kitchen, or after Mass Saturday and Sunday in the school kitchen. Please have the correct money or a cheque made out to St. Joseph's Church in the amount of \$8 for each pie.

We ask for your generosity in helping to make and purchase pies. This is a Parish Fund Raiser. We still need a few more boxes of apples, so if you, or your neighbour, have extra apples that you can donate, please let me know. Donations of sugar will be appreciated.

#### **EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS**

The Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross celebrates three historical events: the finding of the True Cross by Saint Helena, the mother of the emperor Constantine; the dedication of churches built by Constantine on the site of the Holy Sepulchre and Mount Calvary; and the restoration of the True Cross to Jerusalem by the emperor Heraclius II. But in a deeper sense, the feast also celebrates the Holy Cross as the instrument of our salvation. This instrument of torture, designed to degrade the worst of criminals, became the life-giving tree that reversed Adam's Original Sin when he ate from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil in the Garden of Eden.
