

PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

"We are the Catholic Community of St. Joseph's Parish, gathered as disciples of Jesus Christ to worship God, to serve others and to grow as loving members of God's family."



ADVENT and the four ways God speaks to us: the Four Gospels. Let us continue our focus on the Word of God. After Jesus was taken up into heaven in the Ascension and the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples on Pentecost, then the disciples began to spread the Gospel (Word of God) throughout the regions, adapting the message to the distinct needs of the communities they encountered.

Mark the 'Fast Food' Gospel presents the Word of God in the shortest form written to an audience that was young in its faith. It focuses on preparing people to be disciples of Jesus and is written akin to a Discipleship Manual of do's and dont's. A key theme is the conversion of the disciple to believe in Jesus as the Son of God even though he died on the cross. This is done by committing almost 25% of the writing to the death and resurrection event.

Matthew the 'human structure' Gospel presents the Word of God with the most structure. Here Jesus is the new Moses with the new definitive teaching. You will find the greatest number of references to how Jesus fulfills the writings of the prophets. And while the Gospel has a tendency of emphasizing who is to be included or excluded from the kingdom, it also has a tendency of providing the new Christian with a strong structure and identity. In many ways we can thank the strong structure of the church and of the Gospel of Matthew for sustaining the Church during the periods of greatest attack and greatest waning (eg. the Middle Ages).

Luke the 'Inclusion' Gospel presents the Word of God as emphasizing inclusion in the kingdom as opposed to exclusion. It is understood to be written to a Gentile audience so its stories are presented to show how the Gentiles (and other groups considered on the margins of society) are included in God's plan of salvation. And John, the 'Soaring Eagle' Gospel, presents the Word of God in the most mystic of ways. It is very rich in symbolism and in ever deeper layers of meaning. It is written for an audience craving greater spiritual maturity.

Each Gospel presents God's plan of salvation for us through the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus. No one Gospel says it all... each Gospel enriches the other.

And so it must be with how we speak and listen to God and to one another: know that none of our words can say everything (so be cautious in speaking and generous in listening) and that all of our words are to be spoken with an aim to enrich.

COMMIT TO STUDYING DURING ADVENT. Advent is a great time to study something on our faith.


Smither's Pro-life Annual Bake Sale



The Year for Consecrated Life – November 29, 2014 – February 2, 2016

The Year of Consecrated Life began on November 29, 2014 with a Prayer Vigil in the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, Rome, and will end

on February 2, 2016, with the celebration of the World Day for Consecrated Life. The opening of the Year marks the 50th anniversary of the publication of Perfectae Caritatis, the Second Vatican Council Decree on the Adaptation and Renewal of Religious Life, promulgated on October 28, 1965. The Congregation for Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life has released a logo and theme for the Year, together with a letter to consecrated men and women, entitled "Rejoice".
