PORNOGRAPHY HURTS

Mandatory Age Verification for Adult Pornographic Websites

In Canada, there are no laws requiring mandatory age verification mechanisms for adult pornographic websites. Children and adolescents often have unrestricted access to Internet-connected devices, and can easily be exposed to adult content on websites without restriction- whether intentionally or not. Studies show that early exposure to pornography can lead to distorted views of sexuality and its role in fostering healthy relationships. We see such an increase in addiction to pornography in our society and the resulting breakdown in families and relationships.


Grades 4 & 5: Skating days are Nov.8th and 15th.
