DRIVER'S ABSTRACTS, INSURANCE - every year AND CRIMINAL CHECK – every 5 years

Catholic Independent Schools has a policy in place to update all Drivers' Abstracts and photocopied Insurance papers every school year. All volunteers and drivers must replace these annually. This can be done three ways-going to the Access Centre to get a copy of your Drivers' Abstract, bring it into the school and we can photocopy your insurance papers in the office. Phoning 1-800-663-3051, have them fax your Drivers' Abstract to the office at 250-847-9402 and bring in your insurance papers for photocopying. Or online at ICBC <u>https:// onlinebusiness.icbc.com/clio/</u> you can then have it sent or forward it to the office at <u>stj@cispg.ca</u>


